Return trip from Fort Courage Caravan Park to Wentworth via Renmark Road, Perry Sandhills (unsealed roads) Darling Street to Wentworth Showgrounds. It is a great trek route which will show you the extent of the 1956 flood levels and levee banks built to protect the horticultural district in 1956 and 2022/2023.
