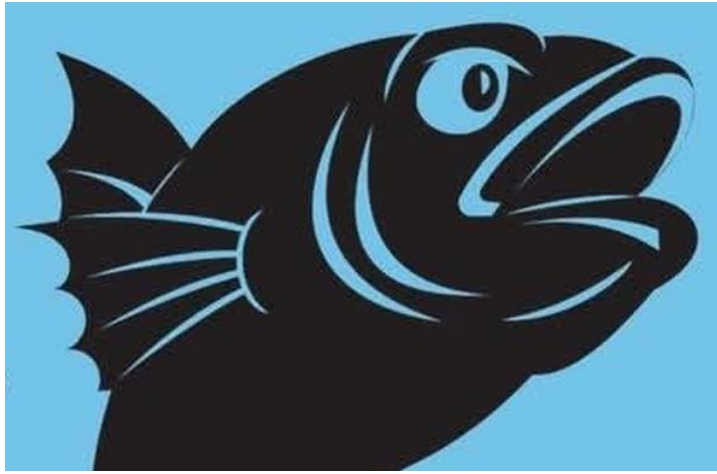

Except for the single seaters, all vehicles consist of a driver/navigator team. The endurance aspect of the racing makes each course a test of driver and navigator skill and mechanical preparation. Each of these forms a championship in its own right. Off Road racing is an

exciting and adrenaline filled discipline of motor sport and is growing in stature with an increasing number of competitors looking to take up the challenge. Competitors attend these rounds from every state with most events incorporating a round of their State Championship which attracts local competitors, sponsors and spectators.

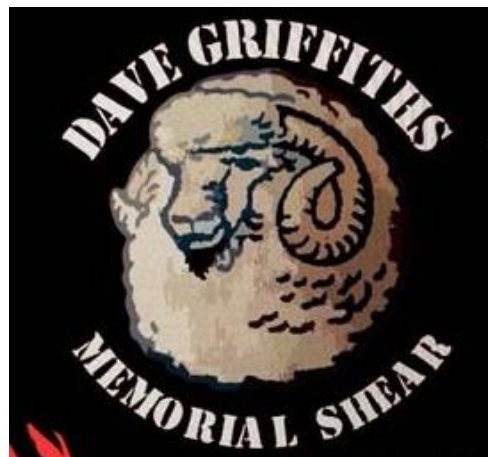
